Twenty top teams will compete at the 37th Annual WIAD State Competition held in Wisconsin Dells. Volunteers will receive e-mailed instructions prior to the event. <u>Note</u>: All assignments take place in Wisconsin Dells* — <u>except</u> for Essay reading.

Speech Judges: 15 Pairs of judges (30 total judges needed from 4:00—8:40 P.M. **on March 12**). Listen, critique and grade the students' prepared and impromptu speeches. A Judges' Handbook is provided online, along with a brief, on-site orientation on the day of the event. A background in public speaking, or affiliation with Toastmasters is a plus. *Dinner included.*

Speech Timers: Stationed in each speech room (15 needed from 4:00—8:40 P.M. **on March 12**). Monitor and time each student's speech. Timer directions are provided online and a brief orientation takes place on the day of the event. Comfort with a stop watch is necessary. *Dinner included.*

Interview Judges: 15 Pairs of judges (30 total judges needed from 4:00—8:40 P.M. **on March 12**). Jointly interview students; guidelines and sample questions are provided, in addition to an online Judges' Handbook and a brief orientation on the day of the event. A background in Human Resources is a plus. *Dinner included.*

Essay Judges: Essay rubric is outlined in the online Judges' Handbook. 20 volunteers will read and critique essays written <u>prior</u> to the State Event — Judges will gather at CESA 7 in Green Bay **(March 3, starting at 8:30AM)**. English, or editing background preferred. *Refreshments provided.*

Test Proctors: Six room monitors are responsible for distributing, collecting and monitoring the testing process at State from 12:30—3:30 P.M. **on March 12** (Day 1 of two-day event), and 9:30—11:25 A.M. **on March 13** (Day 2). A proctor's Orientation Handbook is provided; leadership skills necessary. *Lunch included on Friday only.*

Super Quiz Volunteers: 10 assistants needed from 12:15—2:30 P.M. **on March 13**. Varied assignments include: score verifier, runners, ushers, etc. at the last event of the competition. *Lunch included.*
